- III. Vehicle Status Update.** Staff will provide a brief update on status of previous Section 5310 awards and changes in the MoDOT Transit office.

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021.** Staff will provide an overview of a special allocation of Section 5310 funds for operational-type projects included in the CRRSAA legislation. Staff will also discuss a project sponsored by OATS to coordinate with local health departments to provide transportation for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities to mass COVID-19 vaccination clinics.
- V. CRRSAA Award.** The LCBT will consider awarding \$50,792 in CRRSAA Section 5310 funding to OATS for its COVID-19 Vaccination Transportation Program within the OTO Area.
- VI. Transit Coordination Plan Update Kickoff.** Staff will go over a proposed timeline for updating the *Transit Coordination Plan* (TCP), a plan governing how Section 5310 funds are spent in the OTO area. Staff will also go through the existing TCP, adopted in 2017.
